 - § Nalin says bad sportsmanship started early in AAU. He then read a sportsmanship code that is read at every youth game.
 - § Attempts are under way to make a kit for all schools (Bench bad behavior an example on NFHS)

- o December numbers come in and then schools will make decisions on opting up or requesting going down or appealing.
